



Emergency fund for students with children

This fund supports students of the University of Bonn with children who find themselves in an unforeseen financial emergency. The financial emergency must not be the result of gross negligence on the part of the applicant. The emergency fund can be used to apply for a one-time payment of usually a **maximum of 1000 €**, which is intended to help overcome the acute situation quickly and without complications.

Requirements and application:

The general living expenses of the applicant and their children must be secured. Corresponding proof must be enclosed with the application. As a rule, children should not be more than twelve years of age.

In addition, the application should include the following information and documents:

- cover letter stating exactly what the hardship is and how it arose
- information on the intended use of funds
- proof of income for all members of the household
- curriculum vitae in tabular form
- current certificate of study
- birth certificate of the child/children or child benefit certificate

Applications can be submitted at any point during the year in one single pdf document via e-mail to sekretariat@zgb.uni-bonn.de. There is no legal claim to the granting of support. After completion of the support, proof of the use of the funds must be submitted.
